Ref: Two (2) Hour Call For Tucson Engineers:

Dear Sir

This refers to our discussions concerning the difficulty of Tucson Zone 1 engineers protecting vacancies in the Tucson, Arizona area as a result of extensive interstate construction on I-10, as well as the heavy traffic conditions in this corridor.

Therefore, it is agreed:

- (a) Engineers will be called as near as practical two (2) hours prior to the time they are to report for the on duty point at Tucson.
- (b) This provision does not apply at the far terminals, or at other Southwest Hub Zone 1 on duty points. These locations will retain the current one hour and thirty minute (1'30") call time under the current calling agreement.
- (c) This Agreement may be canceled by either party upon a thirty (30) day cancelation notice.
